Policy No. 1. Attendance at General Membership Meetings

A Co-op is a democracy. It operates on the basis of one member, one vote. Thus, the general membership has the responsibility to remain knowledgeable in the affairs of the Co-op. The control of the affairs of the co-op is exercised at general members meetings.

1.1. Therefore be it resolved that:

- 1.1.1. It is mandatory for every voting member to attend at least two out of every four consecutive general members meetings.
- 1.1.2. Regrets will be accepted for valid reasons providing that proper procedures are followed.
- 1.1.3. The Board of Directors reserves the right to rule in cases of repeated regrets.
- 1.1.4. It is the member's responsibility to see to it that their name/s is/are on the meeting attendance sheet before the meeting adjourns.
- 1.1.5. It is the member's responsibility to review the Agenda and Minutes to remain current on Co-op matters.

This policy approved by the Board of Directors on September 13th 1993.
